Applications are invited from qualified candidates who wish to be considered for appointment as Cameraman/Senior Cameraman at the Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation.

ii. AGE LIMIT

Candidates, unless already in the Service, should not have reached their <u>40th</u> birthday by the closing date for the submission of applications.

iii. QUALIFICATIONS

- A. possess a Cambridge Higher School Certificate <u>or</u> Passes in at least two subjects obtained on one certificate at the General Certificate of Education "Advanced Level" <u>or</u> an equivalent qualification acceptable to the Board of the Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation;
- B. possess a Certificate in Photography / Film making from a recognized institution acceptable to the Board of the Mauritius Broadcasting Corporation; and
- C. computer literate.

Note 1:

- 1. Candidates should produce written evidence of knowledge claimed.
- 2. The onus for the submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and equivalence of qualification (if applicable) from the relevant authorities (Higher Education Commission or Mauritius Qualifications Authority) rests on the candidates. Applications will not be considered in case if non-submission of written evidence of knowledge claimed and Equivalence Certificate, as appropriate, by closing date.

iv. **DUTIES AND SALARY**

- 1. To work with digital, electronic and film cameras in multi and single camera operational conditions to produce films, commercials and other audiovisual materials by combining the use of complex technology with creative visual skills.
- 2. To assist:
 - (i) in editing, post production of programmes and news items; and



- (ii) technician for set up and installation of Jimmy Jib system.
- 3. To perform the following duties; as and when required
 - (ii) to perform sound balancing for programmes and sound recording;
 - (iii) to perform lighting duties; and
 - (iv) to perform on camera live.
- 4. To ensure proper operations of the production on the stage during a live/recording programmes in and outside the studio.
- 5. To coordinate with the Technical Producer/Senior Technical Producer (Roster), Production Assistant/Senior Production Assistant (Roster), Sound Technician/Senior Sound Technician (Roster), News Editor/Senior News Editor and the guests participating in the programmes.
- 6. To take charge and maintain audiovisual and editing equipment.
- 7. To operate drones as and when required.
- 8. To operate Gimbal system with DSLR Camera for production of contents.
- 9. To use ICT in the performance of his duties.
